

## **Web Design I Course Syllabus**

**Course Title:** Web Design I

**Instructor:** Mrs. Tracy Cook

**Course Description:** This course is designed to provide the student with the knowledge and skills needed to design Web pages. Students will develop skills in designing, implementing, and maintaining a Web site using authoring tools.

**NOTE:** Web pages created by students in this course are not to be published without following district guidelines.

**Length of Course:** 1 semester, 90 minutes per day

**Prerequisites:** none

**Instructional Philosophy:** Students will be expected to attend classes; participate in classroom discussions; read required materials; turn in assignments on time; take all tests; complete class projects; refrain from interfering with the learning of others. Students will receive information through lecture, guest speakers, demonstration, and notes projected onto the overhead screen. They will work quietly at all times either independently, with a partner, or in small groups. We will be working with technical schools and an advisory committee to assure that students receive a positive learning experience.

**Course Goals:** Students will be able to:

1. define important Web terminology
2. analyze Web pages
3. locate and incorporate Web images, media, fonts, etc. into Web pages
4. create Web pages using HTML
5. create a Website using Dreamweaver CS3
6. optimize, edit, and create images using Fireworks CS3
7. interview clients
8. make formal presentations

**Major Course Projects:** Students will be expected to:

Create Web pages using Dreamweaver CS3 and HTML and manipulate images using Fireworks CS3.
