**ADDENDUM #2**

All,

Here is the updated info discussed during the mandatory cabling walkthrough. All further questions should be directed to 2019RDA@rdanderson.org.

- Cable requested is CAT6A plenum.
- Jack ends must be purple.
- Network drops are not required to go back to their “wing” closet. Drops can be terminated at the closest closet for convenience. Example: drops at the front of F wing can go back to the E7 network closet if more convenient. Drop should be labeled accordingly.
- Multi-purpose building will need a patch panel and a network drop located on the wall the switch rack is on.
- D wing network closet was misidentified on the school map. The closet is located in the second room on the map.
- The following rooms will have the network drops terminated within the smaller classrooms that are inside the bigger rooms marked on the map: B3, B4, D4, D5 and D6.
- Each network closet will require a new modular patch panel regardless of what is currently there.
- RDA does **NOT** need any patch cables.
